IB Course Selections for Grade 11

Course selections for IB are completed online in February of the grade 10 year. Students may opt to complete the full IB Diploma or select individual courses, and will be registered with the IBO in their grade 12 year as either Diploma Candidates or Course Candidates. After the final results release date, successful Diploma Candidates will receive an IB Diploma, and successful Course Candidates will receive a certificate in each course subject they complete.

Students choose subjects from the following subject groups: studies in language and literature; language acquisition; individuals and societies; sciences; mathematics; and the arts.

Students may opt to study an additional science instead of a subject in the arts.

Diploma Candidate students will register for the following courses:

- IB English 3283
- IB French 3283 (French Immersion) OR IB Spanish 3283 (beginner Spanish)
- IB History of Europe 3285 OR IB Histoire 3286
- *IB Biology 3287 OR IB Physics 3284 AND/OR IB Chemistry 3282
- IB Math 3283
- *IB Music 3282
- TOK 3183

*Please note that Diploma Candidates MUST take one science, but may take up to two sciences (Biology and/or Chemistry, and/or Physics). Alternatively, they may take one science and IB Music.

**Both junior and senior levels of IB Music are completed in the junior year. The fee for the senior level is added to junior year fees, and the cost of one course is deducted from the senior year fees.

Additional Provincial Graduation Requirements

Most provincial graduation requirements have been completed in grade 10 and are covered by the IB Diploma courses, with some exceptions:

PE/Fine Arts credits

Candidates not taking IB Music will have one free period in junior year, and those who are taking IB Music should have one free period in senior year. Those who did not complete physical education credits in grade 10 are encouraged to register for Alt. Health - Yoga 1200 or Healthy Living 1200, and those who are not in Ensemble Performance or who have not completed fine arts credits are encouraged to register for a Fine Arts course of their choice, or NL Studies 2205.

• Optional Language Arts

Most students will have completed their Optional Language Arts credit in grade 10. French Immersion students will have completed Français 1202, and English students may have completed either Writing 2203, French 1200, Drama 2206, or Novel Cinema 3221. Those who have not completed OLA credits should consult with the IB Coordinator and/or the CAS Coordinator.

• Other Required Credits

TOK provides 2 of the 4 credits required in this category. French Immersion students will achieve the other 2 via their French courses. Anyone who has not completed 2 ORC credits beyond the TOK course should consult with the IB Coordinator and/or the CAS Coordinator.
