

Amal Youth and Family Centre:

Connect© is an attachment-based program for parents and caregivers of young people between 8-18 years of age. The program helps caregivers understand basic attachment concepts which can be applied across a broad range of situations. The goal is to promote sensitive and effective parenting that in turn promotes positive adjustment and healthy attachment between young people and their caregivers. Memorial University

Memorial University will continue allocating early entrance scholarship offers under the new <u>Transforming Our Horizons Entrance Scholarship</u> program. Students are considered automatically for these when they <u>apply for admission</u> to Memorial. The admission application deadline is Friday, March 1, 2024.

New this year - Students applying for the <u>Memorial University of Newfoundland Alumni Entrance Scholarship</u> and <u>Dr. Leslie Harris Memorial University Alumni Association Scholarship</u> must submit a completed <u>application</u> by Friday, Dec. 15, 2023.

Students must also apply for admission to Memorial by Friday, Dec. 15, 2023. The application is online and will be automatically sent to our office when a scholarship applicant clicks "submit."
