



## IB Diploma Programme at HHM with Provincial High School Requirements

Français 1202	*All IB Diploma students MUST take one science: those planning to study two sciences may take a combination of IB Chemistry and IB Physics OR IB Chemistry and IB Biology. In preparation for any IB science course, students will take the level 2 course in each science. Those intending to take one science and IB Music in grade 11 should register for the 2000-level science course and and elective such as a Healthy Living/Phys. Ed. or Fine Arts course to satisfy graduation requirements. Fine Arts & Physical Education credits are either completed in grade 10 or 11 or via CAS.
	<b>Provincial graduation requirements completed in grade 10</b> IB French fulfills the Optional Language & Other Required Courses (ORC) graduation requirements. IB Spanish 3283 & 4283 do not fulfil Optional Language Arts credits. ToK 3183 + ToK 4183 fit the ORC (Family Studies). English stream students either complete Writing 2203, Drama 2206, French 1200 or 2200, or Novel Cinema 3221 (Optional Language) in grade 10. Career Ed. course completed in last six weeks of grade 12 – independent project. **These courses all fulfil required graduation credits for Optional Language Arts.		

To complete the full IB Diploma Program students must take one course from each Group in Grade 11 & 12 plus successfully complete the IB Diploma Program Core: CAS + ToK + EE
