We only have two weeks left until our School Leaving events. Here is some general information about each celebration, expectations and tasks that students should complete:

Cap and Gown Ceremony - Wednesday, June 19th at 7:00 p.m. (Live Streamed)

- This event will be held in the Holy Heart Theatre.
- Graduates should have signed up and paid online on Rycor. The fee is \$55.
- Each graduate can bring two people (up to three tickets in total: grad + 2).
- Unfortunately there will be no extra tickets available for families but the ceremony will be live streamed.
- Tickets can be picked up at the theater box office, Tuesday to Friday from 12:00 to 5:00 pm starting on Wednesday, June 12th.
- Caps and gowns can be picked up at the office starting on Wednesday, June 12th and graduates get to keep these items.
- Graduates are asked to be at the school and in their assigned classroom by 6:15 p.m. on June 19. The theater doors will open for guests at 6:30. The seating will be general admission, meaning no reserved seats except for the graduates.

School Leaving Celebration - Thursday, June 20th from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

This event will be hosted in different areas of our school:

- ❖ The **gymnasium** will house a meet-and-greet for graduates, dates and families, with music and numerous photo areas for pictures.
- There will be some sweet treats, hors d'oeuvres, and beverages available in the cafeteria to enjoy.
- ❖ There will be a running slide show for graduates in the LRC and room for seating and pictures.
- Weather pending, the courtyard will be available with seating and photo areas.
- Tickets will be issued for this event as well and can be picked up when the Cap and Gown tickets are picked up at the theater box office. Each graduate can bring three people (up to four tickets in total: grad + 3).
- The attire for this event tends to be more on the formal side, but students and guests are welcome to wear any appropriate attire.

As this is a school sponsored event, there is a clear expectation that students and guests will abide by our regular school rules.
